Information regarding the 17th NACG meeting in Reykjavík 23rd-25th September 2026

The Hotel changed owners on the 1st of September, and the name has changed from Reykjavík Natura to **Hotel Reykjavík Askja**: (<https://www.islandshotel.is/hotels-in-iceland/hotel-reykjavik-askja/>)

Directions from the airport:

The easiest way is to take the Flybus from Keflavík airport (<https://flybus.is/>). Make sure that you book the hotel drop-off option for your accommodation (Hotel Reykjavik Askja) and the bus should take you directly to the hotel. The cost for hotel drop off is 5299 ISK (approx. 38 Euro).

The cheapest way is to take Bus 55 from the airport (bus stop KEF-Airport). The nearest bus-stop to the hotel is called “Öskjuhlíð”. Please note that this includes changing buses, but the schedule varies throughout the day. You can find the bus schedule here: <https://www.straeto.is/en/route-planner/search/0a7643363bd6>. You can pay with a contactless credit or debit card, Apple Pay, or Google Pay directly on the bus. The price is around 2400 ISK (approx. 17 Euro) but make sure to check the departure times which are less frequent than the Flybus.

Information regarding leisure time on Thursday:

On Thursday afternoon we have a dedicated slot for “Time on you own” between 16:30 and 19:00.

Here are a few options we recommend for attendees:

- Guided 5K run around Reykjavík – One of the organizers will take you for a “guided tour run” from the hotel lobby at 17:00 to approximately 18:00 (think of it as more of a jog with stops).
- The hotel has a nice spa where guests can go for the price of 3800 ISK (approx. 27 Euro). To guarantee a spot book your slot here: [Reykjavik Askja Spa booking link](#). Make sure to add the comment “NACG 2026” to get the discounted price. The discount is also included if guests want to book on Wednesday instead.
- There is also a geothermal beach called Nauthólsvík in walking distance from the hotel (about 15 minutes) with a fee of 1500 ISK (approx. 11 Euro) for using the facilities. The beach is equipped with changing facilities and showers, steam-baths and hot tubs: <https://nautholsvik.is/en/>
- If you want to do as the locals, we also have a swimming pool downtown (about 25 min walking distance from the hotel): <https://reykjavik.is/en/sundholl-reykjavik-pool> and a newly renovated one with nice steam baths on the west side of the city (about 7 minutes by car): <https://reykjavik.is/vesturbaejarlaug>. Both have an entrance fee of 1500 ISK (approx. 11 Euro) but the downtown swimming pool is being renovated and can only accommodate 60 people at the same time.
