As an Organisational Member you will have the right to designate individuals from your organisation to represent you in NACG related work, meetings and governance matters.

The Steering Committee of the NACG may decide to impose a membership fee in the future. If such decision is made you will be notified in writing and you will be given reasonable time to pay the membership fee or terminate your membership.
